Paige	<p>Presented the Ashland Connector Report showing 98% on-time pick up and drop offs, 4-5 passengers per hour and very high customer satisfaction. Trips were mainly for shopping and medical. Over 14,000 trips have been provided since January 2020.</p> <p>Presented the Route 63 ridership and a memo sent to City of Eagle Point. Ridership continues to grow despite service suspensions due to Covid and driver shortages.</p>
